# MOREHEAD PLANETARIUM AND SCIENCE CENTER

Morehead Planetarium—now Morehead Planetarium and Science Center—was **dedicated in 1949** as a powerful tool for the education of North Carolinians. It was the first planetarium in the world built on a college campus and only the eighth planetarium built in the United States. Over the past 75 years, millions of North Carolina students, teachers, and families as well as visitors from around the world have benefitted from its innovative science programming.

True to its founding mission, Morehead continues to bring together the unique resources of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to **engage the public for an enhanced understanding of science**. It partners with scientists to develop outstanding planetarium shows, interactive exhibits, hands-on classes, camps, and other programs that allow visitors to experience the wonder of science. It shows people why science matters and how research happening today will change lives tomorrow.

In addition to providing an exceptional visitor experience, Morehead is committed to expanding access and opportunity by delivering educational programming to schools and communities across the state. Outreach efforts range from school-based science programs to targeted student enrichment opportunities to public engagement events. Morehead educators help bring science to life, with exciting and inspiring programs designed to engage young and old alike. Morehead's outreach programs are the embodiment of its commitment to achieving Science for All.

# NORTH CAROLINA SCIENCE FESTIVAL

Morehead is the proud founder and producer of the annual, month-long North Carolina Science Festival (NCSciFest). Launched in 2010, **NCSciFest was the first statewide celebration of science in the United States**, and it continues to be one of the largest events of its kind in the nation. Since its founding, NCSciFest has reached more than 3,686,303 participants from all 100 North Carolina counties.

NCSciFest works with community partners across the state to host events **throughout the month of April** in locations that include K-16 schools, libraries, museums, parks, and science centers. From science nights to engineering competitions to science expos to skywatching parties, NCSciFest events provide participants with opportunities to engage with science in fun and welcoming settings. Event hosts cultivate positive environments that encourage children and teens to see themselves as scientists and spark people's interest in science and science-related career pathways.

In 2025, NCSciFest will celebrate its 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary by highlighting the everyday impact of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) on the lives of people that call North Carolina home.

More than 38,000 students from 478 schools received educational programming from Morehead, including 4,200 students who experienced the mobile planetarium

774 children participated in Morehead summer programming through STEM Connections and Science In the Summer at 19 community partner sites

Morehead relaunched its monthly in-person Carolina Science Café and Teen Science Café programs reaching hundreds of community members young and old

Morehead's website was visited nearly 538,000 times and 33,814 people follow Morehead across all 5 social media channels
